

1) INTRODUCTION:

Hello, this is Xel23, and what you are reading is my fourth FAQ that I've written for GameFAQs.com. This guide is designed to help you retrieve all four Golden Tools in Animal Crossing. Each and every one of them has a clever secret that is vital to your success, and I will point them out. However annoying and tedious working for these things could get, just remember, um...they look pretty, and they are for your catalog! Yeah, that's it. One final note, good Feng-shui could make your life a whole lot easier trying to get the Golden Tools. Don't ask about Feng-shui here, check a FAQ...other than this one.

There are so many people to thank; I'll put the Credits section at the top, since I couldn't of wrote this without the helping hand of the people at GameFAQs.com. :)

3) VERSION HISTORY:

Version 0.2-Sunday, February 16, 2003: Started this guide, finished basic layout, and the universal FAQ sections.

Version 0.5-Tuesday, April 8, 2003: About half of this is done. All I need to complete is the Golden Net and the Golden Rod.

Version 0.75-Sunday, May 4, 2003: Completed the Golden Net section.

Verison Final-Wednesday, May 14, 2003: Finished Golden Rod section.

Version Final-Friday, July 4, 2003: Corrected some minor errors.

4) THE GOLDEN TOOLS:

Golden Axe-

Comments: This is probably the most annoying and tedious of the Golden Tools to get. However, as soon as you figure out the secret, it is really simple. Not to mention this is the coolest Golden Tool, and one you should be proud of at that!

Benefits: The Golden Axe, unlike a regular Axe, never breaks, which makes it good for tree-management and for the red rock.

Requirements: Get a perfect town status at the Wishing Well and keep it for two weeks straight. So if you get out of perfect once, the timer starts all over again. You can check on your town status by talking to the Wishing Well, and selecting "How are things?".

Hints & Tips: The easiest way to do this is to make sure you have 12-14 trees in each acre. You can tell if a tree is in the acre by standing by it. If, to stand directly next to a tree the screen has to scroll, that tree is not part of the acre you were just in. The same works vertically, by standing on top or at the bottom of the trunk.

The Wishing Well takes a scoring for each acre, and that scoring depends on the type of acre. Regular acres are everything EXCEPT the Museum, Trainstation, F-acres, Tailor shop, Pond, and Wishing Well acres. Those 'special' acres scoring is as follows:

Trees:|Points: 0-8 | 0 9-11 | 1 12-14 | 2 15-17 | 1 18+ | 0

Everything else is a regular acre, and scores like this:

Trees:|Points: 0-8 | 0 9-11 | 0 12-14 | 1 15+ | 0

Follow the Wishing Well's hints on which acres need work, and you will get Perfect Town status when you have a total of 14 points or more and no acre needs work. Beware, weeds and trash deduct points, so make sure you give it to Nook, and pull your weeds everyday. Once you get the Perfect, on the next day replant any trees that might of died and check the Wishing Well everyday for 2 weeks to make sure you still have the Perfect, remembering to pull your weeds. After 2 weeks of a non-stop Perfect Town status, visit the Wishing Well and claim your reward.

Golden Net-

Comments: I think this one is very fun and exiting to try and get. However, if you don't have access to the GameBoy Advance island or don't time-travel, this one could take a whole year to accomplish.

Benefits: The Golden Net is twice the size as the normal Net, which makes it much easier to catch Insects.

Requirements: Capture all the different kinds of Insects in the wild at least once, then talk to Mayor Tortimer to receive your reward. They must appear on your list to count, so trading between two characters in your town will not work.

Hints & Tips: I will list the Insects you need to catch chronologically, by months, with the time they are out, and where to find them.

Requirements: Capture all the different kinds of Fish in the wild at least once, talk to Mayor Tortimer to receive your reward. They must appear on your list to count, so trading between two characters in your town will not work.

Hints & Tips: I will list the Fish you need to catch chronologically, by months, with the time they are out, and where to find them.

NOTE= In order to keep my formatting and save space, I left out some of the times for certain fish, more specifically the Barred Knifejaw, Cherry Salmon, Large Char, Arowana, Piranah, and Rainbow Trout. In addition to their listed times, they also come out at 4PM-9PM.

Golden Shovel-

Comments: Most likely to be the easiest, and even more likely to be you first Golden Tool. Really, it is so easy as long as you carefully plan it out.

Benefits: The Golden Shovel randomly digs up 100 Bell bags. Also, you have a better chance of digging up even more money with good Feng-shui.

Requirements: Bury a Shovel found in a Golden Spot (the shining spots on the ground that gives you money), let it grow fully, then shake it. Obviously, this requires 2 Shovels, and a Golden Spot.

Hints & Tips: Every day, look for your Golden Spot. There is one for each human character in your town for each day. Make sure you have your 2nd Shovel with you. When you find it, dig it up and collect your Bells, but DO NOT bury the spot again. Simply pause, select your other Shovel, and press Bury. The Golden Spot should turn into a Golden Sapling. Wait a few days for the Golden Sapling to fully mature (if it is stunted, tough luck, try again) and then shake it. A Golden Shovel should plop down.

There are a number of tips to make sure your plant succeeds. First, don't bother burying a Shovel if the Golden Spot is near a cliff, house, water, etc. Once you do get a good spot, however, make sure to refrain your siblings from digging it up/chopping it down and try not to step on it. Follow this simple ASCII diagram to help you find a good location: XXX XOX XXX X-Space around the tree (make sure it is not water, a house, cliff, etc.) O-Golden Spot where you bury the Shovel Or, if you are really lazy or cheap, just mail the following Universal Code to a Villager in your town (Key Symbol) TartumerMustBe AtLeastHundred If you entered it right you should get a Golden Shovel very soon. 5) FAQ: Q: What is a Pitfall? A: A Pitfall is a round white object with a red exclamation mark on it that you bury in a hole. When a Villager walks on it, they will fall in the hole and get pissed-off. If you fall in one, press A rapidly to get out. Q: What is a DUMMY? A: It is a glitch item left in the programming. It looks like a white triangle with a red Japanese symbol in the middle. Nothing special. Q: What is the "Forbidden 5"? A: The "Forbidden 5" are 5 NES games in this game, specifically Punch-Out!, the Legend of Zelda, Ice Climbers, Mario Bros., and Super Mario Bros. Q: How do I get the "Forbidden 5"? A: You can't legally. Our best guess is that they will be part of a Nintendo giveaway at some point. The only way to get them now is to send your Memory Card in to someone who has it (ask on the Message Boards for more detail) or use an Action Replay, a cheating device. Q: How do I get those floating presents? A: Simple. Run after the floating present, and shake the tree it gets stuck in 6) CONTACT:
