Put their memory card in and go to their city. Go up to a fruit tree and collect the fruit. Make sure that you get at least seven. Come back to your city

and plant them in random locations. In four days check back on them. If one survived, you can plant more or sell them to Tom Nook for 500 bells!

NOTE!: Going to friends cities can make animals living in your city move. Use traveling with caution.

_____ If you have a shovel, dig some holes and place some bells in each hole. Again wait four days and check back. The tree will then be loaded with bells! NOTE !: This is very hard and only works once in about ten times. Find a good spot to plant and go to the Item Sub-Screen. Select the tree that you want to plant and click on it. In the menu that comes up, select plant. In four days the tree will be full grown.
