This is your guide to defeating every foe in the game, including the ever-annoying Gatling Groink. This guide does not cover boss strategies.

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ENEMY STRATEGIES  
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[strat.sec]  
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ATTACK TYPE:            The enemy's element-type or attack-type.

PREFERRED PIKMIN:      The recommended pikmin color to use.

VALUE IN POKOS:        The Pokos you get for collecting the enemy's body underground.

SPROUT VALUE:          The number of pikmin sprouts gained from bringing it's body to the onion.

DIFFICULTY:            The creature's average difficulty.  
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Anode Beetle [en1.sec]

ATTACK TYPE:            Electricity  
PREFERRED PIKMIN:        Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS:          3 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE:            0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY:              EASY

DESCRIPTION: Small black beetles with yellow spots that can send electric messages between one another.

STRATEGY: Throw yellow pikmin onto it's back to expose it's tender underside, then swarm it with the color of your choice.

Anode Dweevil [ene2.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Electricity  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS: 2 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: As the most dangerous dweevil, it's electric shock instantly kills non- yellow sprouts. They are golden and spider-like.

STRATEGY: Constantly throw yellow pikmin onto it's head to make it drop it's prize, then continue throwing yellows to bring it down.

#### Antenna Beetle [ene3.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Kidnaps Pikmin/ Radar  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple  
VALUE IN POKOS: 5 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY

DESCRIPTION: A green flying beetle with huge feet that it uses to hop around.

STRATEGY: Although it cannot destroy pikmin, it is a major annoyance. It can whisle your Pikmin away from you and take them under it's wing. Simply swarm this beetle after it lands from a jump, but watch out for it's sprout-stealing whistle!

#### Armored Cannon Beetle Larva [ene4.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Crushes Pikmin w/ Boulder  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple  
VALUE IN POKOS: 4 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 8 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY-MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A very large green beetle with small stubby feet and a huge boulder-producing snout.

STRATEGY: This armored Cannon Beetle hasn't yet developed it's armor, so avoid it's boulders and swarm it's backside.

Breadbug [ene5.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Steals Treasures/ Bug Bodies  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple  
VALUE IN POKOS: 3 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY-MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A fat brown beetle with roly-polly skin and a large mouth.

STRATEGY: Toss Purple pikmin on its back continually to defeat it. You could also let it steal a treasure, then overpowering it, starting a tug-o-war resulting in the breadbug hitting its head on the research pod. This depletes its health FAST.

\* Breadbug is found only underground.

Bulbmin Mother [ene6.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple  
VALUE IN POKOS: 3 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A small red spotty bulborb with a sprout growing out of its head.

STRATEGY: Throw pikmin onto its back, otherwise, use a spray. Once destroyed, you can control her 10 small bulbmin kids, which have the combined abilities of every pikmin-type.

\* Bulbmin Mother is found only underground.

Bulborb Larva [ene7.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: N/A Olimar/ Louie  
VALUE IN POKOS: 0 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: OLIMAR- EASY | PIKMIN- MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: Small white bulborbs that have no legs. They slither across the ground.

STRATEGY: Dismiss your Pikmin in a safe place, then

walk up to the many larva and punch each one to instantly kill it.

\* Bulborb Larva are found only underground.

#### Bumbling Snitchbug [ene8.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Slams Pilots  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS: 4 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: Blue and green flying bug that uses it's antenna to fly.

STRATEGY: Simply throw yellow pikmin up to it to weigh it down to the grown, then swarm it. Don't let it grab your pilot.

\* Bumbling Snitchbug is found only underground.

#### Careening DirigiBug [ene9.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Drops Large Bomb-rocks  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS: 4 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM-HARD

DESCRIPTION: Green floating bug that relies on colorful balloons to fly. It drops large exploding bombs called "bomb-rocks", featured in Pikmin 1.

STRATEGY: Throw yellow pikmin up to it to weigh it down to the grown, then swarm it. Make sure to watch out for exploding bomb-rocks!

\* Careening Dirigibug is found only underground.

#### Caustic Dweevil [ene10.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Water Globbs  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Blue  
VALUE IN POKOS: 2 Pokos

SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY

DESCRIPTION: A blue spider that steals treasure and bug bodies.

STRATEGY: Constantly throw blue pikmin onto it's head to make it drop it's prize, then continue throwing blues to bring it down.

\* Caustic Dweevil is found only underground.

#### Cloaking Burrow-Nit [enell.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin/ Breaks Bridges  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple  
VALUE IN POKOS: 3 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 8 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A blue shelled bug that has two false eye marks on it's back. When you approach it, you'll find that it's actual face was hidden underground!

STRATEGY: Quickly swarm it with your purple pikmin and avoid it's long, sticky tongue. Also, Burrow-Nits will destroy any nearby bridges, so be sure to defeat Wistful Wild's Nit before building the bridge.

#### Creeping Chrysanthemum [ene12.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple  
VALUE IN POKOS: 7 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 12 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: It's beautiful little flower sprout at first, but once you walk up on it, a huge flower monster with a large mouth and flower eyes will appear!

STRATEGY: Look out for the tell-tale flowers with eyes, then run up to it and quickly swarm it, watching out for it's large mouth. With luck, it may even fall over after an attack, making it's stomach an easy target.

Decorated Cannon Beetle [ene13.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Crushes pikmin with homing  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Red  
VALUE IN POKOS: 4 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 8 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM-HARD

DESCRIPTION: A very large red beetle with small stubby feet and a huge boulder-producing snout.

STRATEGY: This special species of Cannon Beetle doesn't grow any armor, so avoid it's homing boulders and swarm it's backside.

Doodlebug [ene14.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Poisons Sprouts  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: White  
VALUE IN POKOS: 0 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY

DESCRIPTION: A blue-brown Irridescent flint beetle that farts poisonous gases.

STRATEGY: Throw white pikmin at it to make it scuttle away. Be sure to keep your other pikmin away from it!

\* Doodlebug is found only underground.

Dwarf Bulbear [ene15.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple  
VALUE IN POKOS: 2 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 4 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY

DESCRIPTION: A small black and red spotted bulborb with large pink lips.

STRATEGY: Toss a single pikmin of any type directly onto it's head to instantly kill it. For those of us who can't aim, just swarm it, although you may lose a few pikmin. This dwarf may follow a parent Bulbear.



Dwarf Orange Bulborb [ene16.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/Any  
VALUE IN POKOS: 2 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY

DESCRIPTION: A small orange and black spotted bulborb with creepy glowing orange eyes.

STRATEGY: Toss a single pikmin of any type directly onto it's head to instantly kill it. For those of us who can't aim, just swarm it, although you may lose a few pikmin.

\* Dwarf Orange Bulborb is found only underground.

Dwarf Red Bulborb [ene17.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple  
VALUE IN POKOS: 2 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY

DESCRIPTION: A small red and white spotted bulborb that likes to live in groups, away from their parent.

STRATEGY: Toss a single pikmin of any type directly onto it's head to instantly kill it. For those of us who can't aim, just swarm it, although you may lose a few pikmin.

Female Sheargrub [ene18.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Breaks Biridges  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/Any  
VALUE IN POKOS: 1 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 2 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: QUITE EASY

DESCRIPTION: A pink grub with small black eyes and

tiny harmless pinchers.

STRATEGY: Swarm it or toss a pikmin onto it's head. You can't lose a pikmin to this beast, although it can tear down bridges through dangerous territory.

Fiery Blowhog [ene19.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Burns Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Red  
VALUE IN POKOS: 4 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 8 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY-MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A large white pig-type monster with slits for eyes and a red colored snout.

STRATEGY: Swarm it with red pikmin. Make sure that the Blowhog doesn't toss your pikmin into the water when it shakes them off.

Fiery Bulblax [ene20.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats/Burns Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Red  
VALUE IN POKOS: 10 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 12 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A large orange and black striped firey bulborb which appears to be melting from it's own heat.

STRATEGY: Swarm it with red pikmin. Make sure that the Bulblax doesnt eat pikmin. Lead it into water to blow out his fire, then you can attack with purples to bring him down quickly.

Fiery Dweevil [ene21.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Burns Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Red  
VALUE IN POKOS: 2 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY-MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A red spider that steals treasure and bug bodies.

STRATEGY: Constantly throw red pikmin onto it's head to make it drop it's prize, then continue throwing reds to bring it down.

\* Fiery Dweevil is found only underground.

#### Gatling Groink [ene22.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Shoots Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/Any  
VALUE IN POKOS: 7 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 12 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: VERY HARD  
SPECIAL ABILITY: Regenerates after death

DESCRIPTION: An orange creature with fish-like scales and a metal snout. It has a shield that protects it's face, so you must attack from behind.

STRATEGY: Constantly throw purple pikmin onto it's back while avoiding it's homing shots. Don't let it wander into the water, and once you innitiate a fight, don't try to run, as it will follow you back to the landing site. Be sure to collect it's body as soon as it's dead, as it will slowly regenerate all it's health.

#### Greater Spotted Jellyfloat [ene23.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Sucks up Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS: 0 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM-HARD

DESCRIPTION: A large pink transparent jellyfish that floats just above the ground. After you defeat it, any pikmin it ate will be saved.

STRATEGY: Constantly throw yellow pikmin up to the jellyfloat to knock it down, then swarm it with the color of your choice.

\* Greater Spotted Jellyfloat is found only underground.

Hairy Bulborb [ene24.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/Any  
VALUE IN POKOS: 7 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY-MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A large white and blue spotted bulborb with a hairy back end that covers it's spotty side. It has blue eyes and a black snout.

STRATEGY: Start tossing purples onto the bulborb's back to overwhelm it and kill it before it even wakes up.

\* Hairy Bulborb is found only underground.

Hermit Crawmad [ene25.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/White  
VALUE IN POKOS: 3 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 8 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY-MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A lobster-like enemy that lives in a burrow and can often be found out of water. It's back end has no shell, so that's it's weak spot.

STRATEGY: Lure it out of it's burrow with a white pikmin, then, as it charges at the pikmin, call it to you and swarm it's backside as it tries to return to it's burrow. This way, even if it escapes to it's burrow with the pikmin, it'll be poisoned and damaged.

Honeywisp [ene26.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: N/A  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS: 0 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY

DESCRIPTION: A transparent flying blob that holds nectar that it WOULD be taking back to it's young, if

it wasn't for the evil pikmin!

STRATEGY: Toss one yellow pikmin up to it to make it lose it's nectar, then flower the pikmin of your choice with it's lost nectar glob.

Iridescent Flint Beetle [ene27.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: N/A  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/Any  
VALUE IN POKOS: 0 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY

DESCRIPTION: A shiny green beetle that holds valuable nectar and pellets.

STRATEGY: Toss one purple pikmin on it to make it release it's nectar, but keep reds away from it, as they'll mindlessly chase it, although they'll never truly be able to defeat it!

Iridescent Glint Beetle [ene28.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: N/A  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/Any  
VALUE IN POKOS: 0 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY

DESCRIPTION: A shiny gold beetle that holds valuable nectar and sprays, and in some circumstances, a very valuable treasure!

STRATEGY: Toss one purple pikmin on it to make it release it's treasure, but do it fast, as Glint Beetles only surface for a few seconds at a time.

Lesser Spotted Jellyfloat [ene29.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Sucks up Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS: 0 Pokos

SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A small green transparent jellyfish that floats just above the ground. After you defeat it, any pikmin it ate will be saved.

STRATEGY: Constantly throw yellow pikmin up to the jellyfloat to knock it down, then swarm it with the color of your choice. This species is the "dwarf bulborb" of jellyfloats, so it goes down much faster than greater jellyfloats.

\* Lesser Spotted Jellyfloat is found only underground.

#### Male Sheargrub [ene30.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin/ Breaks bridges  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/Any  
VALUE IN POKOS: 2 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 3 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: QUITE EASY

DESCRIPTION: A purple grub with small black eyes and tiny but deadly pinchers.

STRATEGY: Swarm it or toss a pikmin onto it's head. You can only lose a few pikmin to this beast, although it can tear down bridges through dangerous territory.

#### Mamuta [ene31.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Squases captains/ Plants pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/Any  
VALUE IN POKOS: 3 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A gray rock creature with strong arms and strange tribal markings.

STRATEGY: Toss purple pikmin onto it's head quickly before it can replant too many pikmin, although Mamuta's green thumb will cause all replanted pikmin to be flowered.

\* Mamuta is found only underground.

Mitite [ene32.sec]

ATTACK TYPE:               Scares Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN:         Purple/Any  
VALUE IN POKOS:           1 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE:             2 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY:                QUITE EASY

DESCRIPTION: A pink shelled creature that can be born from nectar eggs.

STRATEGY: Call your scared pikmin to you, then toss one purple pikmin on it's head to kill it.

Munge Dweevil [ene33.sec]

ATTACK TYPE:               Poisons Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN:         White  
VALUE IN POKOS:           2 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE:             0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY:                MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A purple spider that steals treasure and bug bodies.

STRATEGY: Constantly throw white pikmin onto it's head to make it drop it's prize, then continue throwing whites to bring it down.

\* Munge Dweevil is found only underground.

Orange Bulborb [ene34.sec]

ATTACK TYPE:               Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN:         Purple/any  
VALUE IN POKOS:           7 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE:             12 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY:                MEDIUM-HARD

DESCRIPTION: A large orange and black spotted bulborb with a bad attitude. This is one of the most difficult grub-dog type enemies.

STRATEGY: Start tossing purples onto the bulborb's back to take away slivers of HP at a time, and be sure to keep away from it's rapid-fire mouth, as this is one of

the few non-boss enemies that can eat over 5 pikmin at a time.

Puffy Blowhog [ene35.sec]

Pikmin

ATTACK TYPE: Blows away Pikmin/ Unflowers

PREFERRED PIKMIN: Yellow

VALUE IN POKOS: 0 Pokos

SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts

DIFFICULTY: EASY-MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A brilliant purple puffball with a long snout that it uses to blow the flowers off of pikmin. It has a set of soft spikes in it's back. It hovers just above the ground.

STRATEGY: Start tossing yellows up to it to weigh it down, then swarm it with the pikmin color of your choice. Be sure to avoid it's flower-damaging breath.

Ravenous Whiskerpillar [ene36.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Valuable Potion Berries

PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/Any

VALUE IN POKOS: 0 Pokos

SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts

DIFFICULTY: QUITE EASY

DESCRIPTION: A nasty little maggot with a fuzzy mouth that loves to gang up around and eat valuable potion-making berries.

STRATEGY: Swarm it with any color. If it's eating a berry from a berry plant, send some pikmin up the berry plant to knock it down, then attack it.

Red Bulborb [ene37.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin

PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/Any

VALUE IN POKOS: 7 Pokos

SPROUT VALUE: 12 Pikmin Sprouts

DIFFICULTY: EASY-MEDIUM



DESCRIPTION: A large red and white spotted bulborb is nocturnal, so it'll be snoozing when you find it.

STRATEGY: Start tossing purples onto the bulborb's back to overwhelm it and kill it before it even wakes up.

Shearwig [ene38.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple/Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS: 2 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 4 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: EASY-MEDIUM  
SPECIAL ABILITY: REGENERATION WHEN NEAR DEATH

DESCRIPTION: A green male sheargrub that can take to the sky. It regains energy while it flies.

STRATEGY: Swarm it with purples to start off the fight. Once it loses much of it's health and is about to die, it will fly up into the air to recover. Toss one yellows up to it to kill it instantly.

SkitterLeaf [ene39.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: N/A  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: PURPLE/Any  
VALUE IN POKOS: 1 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 1 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: QUITE EASY

DESCRIPTION: A leaf with eyes and legs.

STRATEGY: Swarm it with purples. You might lose track of it since it blends in with the planet's foilage.

Snow Dwarf [ene40.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: PURPLE/Any  
VALUE IN POKOS: 2 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: QUITE EASY

DESCRIPTION: A small white and blue spotted bulborb that likes to live in groups, away from their parent.

STRATEGY: Toss a single pikmin of any type directly onto it's head to instantly kill it. For those of us who can't aim, just swarm it, although you may lose a few pikmin. This one's health goes down quickly, making it the easiest dwarf grub-dog type enemy.

\* Snow Dwarf is found only underground.

#### Spotty Bulbear [ene41.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: PURPLE/White  
VALUE IN POKOS: 10 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 12 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: HARD

DESCRIPTION: A very large black and red bulborb with very thick pink lips and a square face. This guy never sleeps, and will automatically home in on you, even from the other side of Perplexing Pool, and invade your base. This guy is really different from Pikmin 1.

STRATEGY: Wait for this monstrosity to make it to your base, then use a white pikmin to distract it. While it is in the act of being poisoned, run behind him and toss loads of pikmin on his back to make him lose a few slivers of hp. Rinse and repeat.

#### Swooping Snitchbug [ene42.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Replants Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS: 4 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 4 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A green fly that floats with it's antenna and rubs it's hands together in a menacing sort of way.

STRATEGY: Toss pikmin up to it to weigh it down, then swarm it. Pick up any pikmin that have been planted after the battle.

#### Toady Bloyster [ene43.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS: 10 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 25 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM-HARD

DESCRIPTION: A pink oyster- type enemy found out of it's shell. It has a tender flower like set of gills attached to it's tail.

STRATEGY: This enemy gives you many sprouts! It's only hard if you don't have a decent strategy. Run around to the back of the toady bloyster and toss pikmin at it's tail until it's finished off. Avoid it's multiple tounge.

#### Unmarked Spectralids [ene44.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Eats Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS: 1 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 1 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: QUITE EASY

DESCRIPTION: A butterfly that holds nectar.

STRATEGY: Toss pikmin up to it to kill it. Pick up the body and it's nectar.

#### Volatile Dweevil [ene45.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Blows Pikmin Up  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: N/A  
VALUE IN POKOS: 0 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: QUITE EASY

DESCRIPTION: A spider with a bomb for an abdomen.

STRATEGY: Lure it away from the pikmin and let it blow up.

\* Volatile Dweevil is found only underground.

Water Duple [ene46.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Blows Pikmin Up  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple  
VALUE IN POKOS: 3 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 5 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A blue swimming bug with a large mouth and no eyes. They can travel in and out of water.

STRATEGY: Toss a single pikmin of any type directly onto it's head to instantly kill it. For those of us who can't aim, just swarm it, although you may lose a lot pikmin.

Watery Blowhog [ene47.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Drowns Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Blue  
VALUE IN POKOS: 4 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 8 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A large white pig-type monster with slits for eyes and a blue colored snout.

STRATEGY: Swarm it with blue pikmin. Make sure that the Blowhog doesn't toss your pikmin into bad situations when it shakes them off.

Withering Blowhog [ene48.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Instantly Unflowers Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Yellow  
VALUE IN POKOS: 0 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A large red floating hog with a yellow snout that it uses to blow the flowers off of flower pikmin.

STRATEGY: Start tossing yellows up to it to weigh it down, then warm it with the pikmin color of your choice. Be sure to avoid it's flower destroying breath.

Wogpole [ene49.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: N/A  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Blue  
VALUE IN POKOS: 1 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 1 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: QUITE EASY

DESCRIPTION: A blue tadpole that is very speedy.

STRATEGY: Swarm it with blues. Blue Pikmin will automatically chase it. They're the flint beetles of the water.

Wollywog [ene50.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Smashes Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple  
VALUE IN POKOS: 7 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 0 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: HARD

DESCRIPTION: A medium sized green frog with beady, demon-like red eyes.

STRATEGY: Swarm it with Purples if it's on land, or swarm it with blues if it's in water. Swarming it with lots of pikmin will stop it from jumping, making it a piece of cake. If it manages to escape, it will crush all of the pikmin that were attacking it, so watch out!

Yellow Wollywog [ene51.sec]

ATTACK TYPE: Smashes Pikmin  
PREFERRED PIKMIN: Purple  
VALUE IN POKOS: 7 Pokos  
SPROUT VALUE: 8 Pikmin Sprouts  
DIFFICULTY: MEDIUM

DESCRIPTION: A large sized yellow frog with tiny demon eyes. It's strangely tall looking for a frog.

STRATEGY: Swarm it with Purples if it's on land, or

swarm it with blues if it's in water. Swarming it with lots of pikmin will stop it from jumping, making it a piece of cake. If it manages to escape, it will crush all of the pikmin that were attacking it, so watch out! This version has a smaller jumping range than regular Wollywogs.

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Some enemies have completely dissapeared or have been changed from Pikmin 1. Here is a guide to all of these obvious and not so obvious changes.

CHANGED ENEMIES-

Armored Cannon Beetle no longer has armor. It now has only one snout, so you can't use pikmin to stop it up any more.

Breadbugs used to only come out of hiding if there was a treasure lying around in the level, but now, they do laps around the level instead of hiding. Breadbugs also used to grab on to items that pikmin were already holding, but now, if pikmin latch on before the breadbug does, it'll automatically give up.

Dwarf Bulbears have a smaller range than in Pikmin 1, and they are generally less vicious. Maybe that's to make up for those incredibly annoying changes made to Bulbears...

Mamutas are showing their mean streaks in this game. In Pikmin 1, Mamutas would never plant pikmin or attack captains unless they were attacked first. Now, Mamutas track you and plant any pikmin within their range, even if you haven't attacked them.

Puffy Blowhog now has a much stronger breath.

Spotty Bulbears have been drastically changed. They are now much more vicious than in Pikmin 1. They never sleep, and at the start of the level, they'll automatically march toward your base, kind of like Smokky Progg in Pikmin 1. The can eat loads of pikmin in one gulp now, and they usually have Dwarf Bulbear

followers that usually confuse you even more. Once you killed a Bulbear in Pikmin 1, that was it, but now, they'll regenerate if you don't quickly take their bodies to the onion or research pod!

#### LOST ENEMIES

Goolix was a water creature that suffocated all non-blue pikmin that tried to attack it.

Puffstool was a walking mushroom that could turn your pikmin into evil "purple zombies" that attacked Olimar. Maybe they took this one out so people wouldn't confuse good purple pikmin from bad ones? Chances are, we'll never know...
