On the surface, there seems to be no points to be earned in the game. Obviously, there are, or this guide wouldn't exist! The way it works is thus: bronze medals that you earn from performing very well in missions give you three points. Silver medals give you six points, while gold medals, awarded for outstanding performance in the mission, award you a whopping TEN points!

These medals don't add up, though. Let's say you go through Death Star Attack, and get a bronze medal the first time. The next time through, you grab a silver medal. These don't add up to make nine points. Instead, you get the six points for the silver medal. So keep this in mind. Without further ado, here is the chart!
