Section: GETTING STARTED [!STA]

In order to first start your Figurine building you first must find Harley, in the back room of his house in Asgard. His home is right

under Linar and Aisha's home. The first time he appears there is after you destroy Kvar's Asgard Human Ranch.

If for some reason he is not there make sure that currently your party is full (6 people if you've only been to Sylvarant, and 8 if you've been to Tethe'alla), and that you don't have some other odd story related condition (Such as Colette having no voice). If for some reason he's still not showing up, just come back later after more of the story progresses. You can't miss finding him altogether.

Anyway once you speak with Harley he'll give you the Figurine collection book and a few pellets. With this new key item go to Dirk's house and talk to him. You can now start making Figurines by processing pellets. To do so when ever you like examine the oven in Dirk's house.

You can make Figurines using Pellets, Fine pellets, or Super pellets. You can also try melding them with Rare pellets to create more interesting characters.

If this is your first game Dirk can make up to 60 Figurines at once (Using 20 Pellets, 20 Fine pellets, and 20 Super pellets), with a chance of 20 of those being rare if you use Rare pellets. However if you are in a New game+ and bought "30 items" from the Grade shop Dirk can make up to 90 Figurines at once, with a chance of 30 of them being rare.

Section: COMMON RECIPE LISTS [!COM]

You might be wondering why the word "Common" is used. It is because the recipes to make a Figurine are not set in stone. On different occasions I've made Figurines under the Fine pellet list with only Pellets, or made rare figurines without Rare pellets. The lists here are instead for the recipes that will most likely get you the desired Figurine.

Dirk is a rather random guy, and he'll make the Figurines at random. I suggest that if you want specific creations you should use the save point in his home, and reload if you are not satisfied with his work.

And as mentioned before about making rare Figurines without Rare pellets, with Dirk and his randomness the reverse holds true, he will sometimes make generic Figurines while wasting your Rare pellets. Thanks dad!

In order to make a figurine the party must have the potential to meet that person and know who it is. An example of the first point is you don't actually have to speak with the people in Flanoir to make them, you simply need to have been to Flanoir, or even just be able to fly there. An example of the second point is that you can't make characters such as Yuan before you know his true name, or Rodyle if the part all ready left before he was on screen.

In order to make Figurines you of course need pellets. Pellets are not just common items that you can buy from shops with your Gald. Pellets can be found in some dungeon treasure chests, and drop off some monsters such as Basilisks and Ghouls. But rather than just relying on the randomness of battle drops you can use the skills of your characters, Colette's stealing and Zelos' charming of women.

Part: COLETTE AND STEALING                                 [!COL]

With Colette's techs Item Thief (Level 10) and Item Rover (Level 28) she has a chance of stealing items from enemies by tripping on to them. But why just go by a chance, when you can get items guaranteed! Yes, with Colette's Compound EX-skill "Item Getter" she has a 100% chance of gaining an item via stealing. In order for to gain "Item Getter" give her the following EX-skills:

- level 1: Sharp-eyed
- level 2: Magical
- level 3: Lucky
- level 4: Stat boost

Keep in mind that even with Item Getter the computer is a really bad thief, often Colette will fall short of her target and waste time and tp. I suggest actually controlling Colette and stealing the items yourself. Also set your allies to Hold Position so they don't kill off your prey.

So what monsters are good targets for Colette to steal pellets from?

For normal Pellets the only enemy you can actually steal from are Jellyfish, which are found in the sewers of Meltokio. These enemies are a tad rare, so if you want to you can run from battle and keep running into the enemy avatar until you fight one.

There are a two enemies you can get Fine pellets from: Gold Slimes in the Temple of Lightning, and Giant shells in the Temple of Earth. I go for Giant shells as they are also close to the good gald dropping Dragon.

For Super pellets you can try Lobos in the Temple of Ice, Ghouls in

Gaoracchia forest, or Spiked snails in Latheon Gorge.

Rare pellets are of course the hardest to gain with Colette. They can only be stolen from Phantom Knights, rare enemies in Derris-Kharlan

Part: ZELOS AND SWOONING [!ZEL]

Zelos' level 2 EX-skill "Personal" allows him a chance to gain items if he is the avatar that talks to female npcs. What he can gain is based off his current LUK stat. If you're aiming for something like Rare pellets suit Zelos up with LUK+ items suck as Rabbit feet, and avoid using LUK- items such as Soul Eater.

However keep in mind that the items he gets are still random, and that if you're able to get rare items such as Rare pellets it also means he can get other unwanted rare items. In fact having too much LUK can prevent him from gaining some of the more common items such as normal Pellets.

Also something you might not have noted is that Zelos' LUK can raise or fall each time he tries to hit one a woman. It mainly has to do with the woman's recation, but it's also a bit random. You should stick to places where Zelos is popular, such as Meltokio, and avoid depressing places like Exire.

Like I mentioned in the intro, there is a reward to gaining all 288 figurines. Once the collection is finished return to Asgard and talk to Harley once again. There will be a brief scene in which Genis will gain the title "Figurine Collector".

And as I mentioned before I really don't see the point of this title, as it gives Genis big boosts to STR and DEF, things he won't really need, and nothing to his TP or INT. It might be helpful in Mania mode since the enemy tends to ignore the fighters and take out Genis first.
