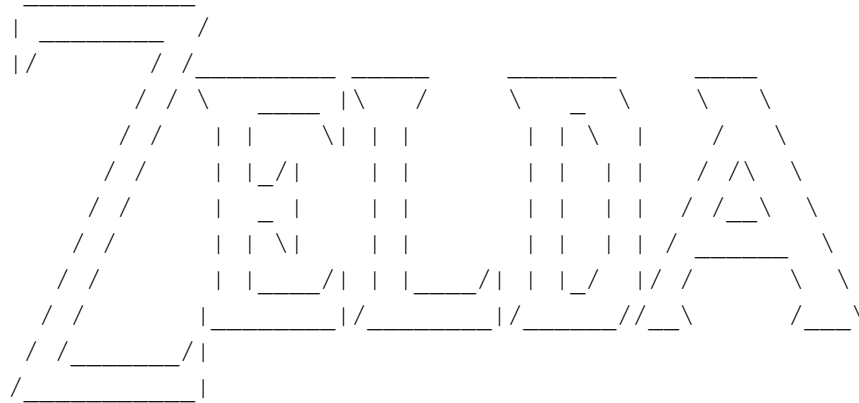

VIII. Boss Guide

Bosses of the game:

GOHMA

Location: Deku Tree	
Difficulty: Very Easy	
Weapons Uses: Fairy Slingshot, Deku nuts, Sword	
Reward: Koriki Emerald, Heart Container	

This is a pretty easy boss. When Gohma's eye turns red, use the Fairy Slingshot or a Deku nut to stun it, then repeatedly hit it with your sword. When it climbs up on the ceiling, use the fairy slingshot on it when its eye turns red to both stun it and bring it down.

KING DODONGO

Location: Dodongo's Cavern	
Difficulty: Very Easy	
Weapons Uses: Bombs, Hylian Shield, Sword	
Reward: Goron's Ruby, Heart Container	

A very easy boss. When he starts to suck in air, throw a bomb at him. He will swallow it and be stunned. After that, hit him with your sword. He will then roll around, when hes doing that, use the hylian shield so you wont take damage. Do this four times to kill him.

BARINADE
=====

|Location: Jabu Jabu |
|Difficulty: Medium |
|Weapons Uses: Boomerang, Sword |
Reward: Zora's Sapphire, Heart Container

The first thing to do is to take out barinades electric veins at the top of its structure. After that, he will start spinning around. Wait until it stops and kill the Bari protecting it. After there all dead, the nucleus will be left exposed. Stun it with your boomerang and hit it with your sword. If it goes under the membrane and blast you with electric blast, back up and wait for it to come out.

PHANTOM GANON
=====

|Location: Forest Temple |
|Difficulty: Hard |
|Weapons Uses: Arrows, Sword |
|Reward: Forest Medallion, Heart Container, |
Access to the pedestal of time, Prelude of light

As you begin the battle, the phantom will jump from painting to painting on horse. Two of the painting will have him running toward you, while one is a fake one. Shoot the one that has the phantom jumping out of a portal. The second and last phase is when he shoots electric energy at you. You need to use either your sword or a well placed bottle swing to counter the blow. Keep doing this until he slips up and stunned, and hit him with your sword until hes dead.

VOVAGIA
=====

|Location: Fire Temple |
|Difficulty: Medium |
|Weapons Uses: Megaton Hammer |
Reward: Fire Medallion, Heart Container

This battle really doesn't have a set attack pattern, but he does have 3 different attacks that are done at random. The first attack is to simply poke his head out of one of the holes, the second is to fly in the air, and the third is to fly into the ceiling and cause rocks to fly down. When he pokes his head out, hit him with the megaton hammer. Keep doing this until he is dead

MORPHA
=====

|Location: Water Temple |
|Difficulty: Medium |
|Weapons Uses: Longshot, sword |
|Reward: Water Medallion, Heart Container |

When the battle begins, go into one of the corners and wait for morphas nucleus to show up. When it does, latch onto it with the longshot and pull it over to where you are. Hit it with your sword do damage this. Repeat until its dead

=====

BONGO BONGO

=====

|Location: Shadow Temple |
|Difficulty: Medium |
|Weapons Uses: Lens of Truth, Arrows, Sword |
|Reward: Shadow Medallion, Heart Container |

Before going into the boss battle room, make sure you have your magic meter at full. It will make the battle easier. Shoot both of the hands and then the eye to stun it, and then use your sword to damage Bongo Bongo. Do this until he is dead.

KONATE & KOSUME (AKA: TWINROVA)

=====

|Location: Spirit Temple |
|Difficulty: Medium |
|Weapons Uses: Mirror Shield, Sword |
|Reward: Spirit Medallion, Heart Container |

A long, but easy battle. When the battle begins, go to one of the pillars in the room and wait for one of the sisters to hit you with a elemental blast. When she does, reflect it at the other sister to damage her.

After awhile, they will merge into twinrova. When they do that, gather three of the same spell and reflect it at twinrova to stun her. When shes stunned, hit her with your sword. A word of caucion, if you get one element blast and refect the opposite, you will lose the mirror shields stored energy.

GANONDORF

=====

|Location: Ganons Castle |
|Difficulty: Hard |
|Weapons Uses: Light Arrows, Sword |
|Reward: None |

If you remember the forest temples battle with the phantom, it is just like that. When the battle begins, go into one of the corners of the arena. When G-Dorf does the energy attack, do the same thing you did with the phantom. While Ganondorf is stunned, use a light arrow on him. While hes stunned, lock onto him with L targeting and fire your longshot at him to pull yourself over to him.

If you have the Biggorons sword, use that for more damage. After he goes back into the air, use the longshot on one of the four corners. After awhile, he may use a attack where he gathers energy, simply hit him with a light arrow when hes doing that and do the same thing you've been doing.

GANON

=====

|Location: Ganons Tower Remains |
|Difficulty: Medium/Hard |
|Weapons Uses: Megaton Hammer, sword, light arrow |
|Reward: Ending |

Since you do not have the Master Sword in this fight, equip either the Megaton Hammer or the Biggorons sword if you had it. At first, you can easily sidestep or roll under ganon to get to his tail and hit it. After the fire nulls and you get the master sword, it becomes harder.

Use a light arrow to stun him and then go to where his tail is and hit him with the master sword. If you run out of magic, use deku nuts for a less powerful stun, but enough time to roll under his legs. After he falls for the last time, slash him with your sword for the ending.

A:

Anibus

Strength: Weak

Location: Spirit Temple

Info: When your a kid, use Dins fire on it. When your a adult, use a fire arrow on it. Attacks with fire blast

Armos

Strength: Normal

Location: Anywhere with a moveable knight statue

Info: When your a kid, use a bomb to damage it, when your a adult, hit it with your master sword. Will explode before it dies

B:

Baby Dogodono

Strength: Weak

Location: Dogdono's Cavern

Info: Can go underground and pops out of the ground. After you kill it, it will explode

Bari:

Strength: Normal

Location: Jabu Jabu

Info: Electrical. Will shock you when you use your sword. After it is killed, it will split up into 3 Biri's

Beamos

Strength: Normal

Location: Dogdono's Cavern, Shadow Temple, Spirit Temple, Ganons Castle

Info: Throw a bomb at its head to kill it. Greater chance if you let the fuse about to go out, lock on, and throw the bomb at it

Big Deku Baba

Strength: Weak

Location: Deku Tree(MQ), Koriki Forest, Forest Temple

Info: Just like the normal Deku baba, cut it long to get a deku stick, kill it normally to get some deku nuts

Bigocto

Strength: Strong

Location: Jabu Jabu

Info: Stun from behind to get access to the green weakpoint. If you are knocked down, quickly get up so you can stun it

Big Poe

Strength: Weak

Location: Hyrule Field (Adult, 10 of them)

Info: These types of poes only come out on horseback. When one appears, quickly shoot it with your bow to kill it. If you wait, it will disappear until you come back to the field again

Biri

Strength: Weak

Location: Jabu Jabu

Info: Electrically charged. Use boomerang to kill.

Big Skulltula

Strength: Weak

Location: Shadow Temple

Info: All it really is a big version of the skulltula. Kill it the same way you would normally

Blue Bubble

Strength: Weak

Location: Forest Temple, Shadow Temple

Info: Use your shield to stop the blue flames and use your other weapons to kill it

Blue Tektite

Strength: Weak

Location: Lake Hylia, Water Temple

Info: Can hop on water. Lure to land and then attack

Business Scrub

Strength: Weak

Location: Various

Info: When your a kid, reflect there shots back at them. As a adult, do the same or use the megaton hammer.

D:

Dark Link

Strength: Very Strong

Location: Water Temple

Info: There really is no strategy for him besides using the biggorons sword makes it easier

Dead Hand

Strength: Strong

Location: Bottom of the well, Shadow Temple

Info: While as a kid, wait for one of the hands to grab you, then press the buttons on the pad to escape. As a adult, use the lens of truth to find where its buried, and then use a bomb at that place

Deku Baba

Strength: Weak

Location: Deku Tree, Koriki forest, Forest Temple
Info: Cut longways for a deku stick, kill it normally for
deku nuts

Deku Scrub

Strength: Weak
Location: The Deku Tree
Info: Reflect the deku seed back at it with your shield

Dinofolos

Strength: Normal
Location: Gerudo Training Ground
Info: Exact same as Lizardfolos

Dodongo

Strength: Strong
Location: Dogdono's Cavern
Info: Hit it from behind to do damage or use a bomb

F:

Fire Keese

Strength: Weak
Location: Dogdono's Cavern, Fire Temple, Ganons Castle
Info: Keese will fly into fire to become fire keese. If you have the
deku shield equipped, you will lose it.

Flare Dancer

Strength: Strong
Location: Fire Temple
Info: Before you get the megaton hammer, use the hookshot on the center
to pull out his weak point and hit it. When you have the hammer, just use
that to cease the flames

Floormaster

Strength: Strong
Location: Forest Temple, Shadow Temple
Info: When it turns green, it cannot be damaged. When it dies, you
need to hit all three of the mini versions of itself or those pieces
will regenerate

Freezard

Strength: Normal
Location: Ice Cavern, Ganons Castle
Info: Can freeze you

G:

Gerudo Thief

Strength: Very Strong
Location: Gerudo Fortress
Info: Whenever she winds up a spin attack, use your shield
or you will wind up back in your cell

Gibido

Strength: Normal
Location: Inside the Well
Info: Exact same as ReDead's

Gohma Egg

Strength: Harmless

Location: Deku Tree, Dogdono's Cavern (MQ)

Info: Will hatch in to Gohma larvae when you get close

Gohma Larvae

Strength: Weak

Location: Deku Tree, Dogdono's Cavern (MQ)

Info: When its eye turns red, its about to attack

Green Bubble

Strength: Normal

Location: Forest Temple, Bottom of the Well

Info: Same with Blue Bubble

Guay

Strength: Weak

Location: Lon Lon Ranch, Desert Colossus

Info: Flies in packs, Similar to the keese

I:

Ice Keese

Strength: Strong

Location: Ice Cavern

Info: Can freeze you on impact

Iron Knuckle

Strength: Very Strong

Location: Fire Temple(MQ), Spirit Temple, Ganons Castle

Info: Use Nayru's love before you fight it. Each blow will make it faster. Its attack can take off 7 hearts

K:

Keese

Strength: Weak

Location: Almost Every dungeon

Info: Can become fire keese when it flys into fire

L:

Leever

Strength: Weak

Location: Haunted Wasteland Desert Colossus

Info: Can pop out of sand. Very fast

Lizalfolos

Strength: Normal

Location: Many Locations

Info: Fights like stafolos. Usually come in pairs.

Like Like

Strength: Strong

Location: Jabu Jabu(MQ), Fire Temple, Bottom of the well, Water Temple, Shadow Temple, Ganons Castle

Info: Will eat both Hyliand Shield, Deku Shield, and any color tunic besides green. Defeat it quickly to get your stuff back

M:

Mad Scrub

Strength: Weak

Location: Various

Info: Exact same as Deku/Business scrub, only fires more seeds at you at a faster rate

Moblin

Strength: Strong

Location: Sacred Forest Meadow

Info: Hookshot it both when it isn't looking and while its turned

O:

Octorock

Strength: Weak

Location: almost anywhere with water

Info: Same as deku scrub series

P:

Peahat

Strength: Strong

Location: Hyrule Field(Kid)

Info: Get under its blades and attack it with your sword

Poe

Strength: Normal

Location: Graveyard, Dogdono's Cavern(MQ), Hyrule Field(Adult)

Info: Will disappear when Z-Targeted

R:

Red Bubble

Strength: Weak

Location: Death mountain crater, Fire Temple

Info: Pops out of lava

Red Tektite

Strength: Weak

Location: Death Mountain

Info: Same as B. Tektite, only without the water ability

ReDead

Strength: Normal

Location: Various

Info: Will freeze you if you get close. Press buttons to escape freeze

S:

Shabom

Strength: Weak
Location: Jabu Jabu
Info: immune to the sword

Shell Blade

Strength: Strong
Location: Water Temple
Info: When it opens its muscle, attack it with your sword or hookshot

Skullwalltula

Strength: Weak
Location: Deku Tree, Forest Temple, Death Mountain
Info: Will attack you if you get close while your climbing

Spike

Strength: Weak
Location: Water Temple
Info: Withdraws spikes if attacked with hookshot or shield

Stafolos

Strength: Strong
Location: Various
Info: Similar to Lizalfos

Stinger

Strength: Weak
Location: Jabu Jabu, Water Temple
Info: Stay's in water until someone gets close. Use hookshot, boomerang, or fairy bow/slingshot to kill it

T:

Tailparistan

Strength: Strong
Location: Jabu Jabu
Info: Use boomerang on it. Will take damage if you use your sword on it

Torch Slug

Strength: Weak
Location: Various
Info: None

W:

Wallmaster

Strength: Strong
Location: Various
Info: Shadow will appear when its about to fall down. Run around to avoid it and then attack it with your sword. If you are grabbed, you are brought back to the beginning

White Bubble

Strength: Weak
Location: Spirit Temple
Info: Flys around very fast

White Wolfos

Strength: Weak

Location: Various

Info: EXACT same as Gray Wolfos

Wolfos

Strength: Weak

Location: Various
