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What is this Guide For?

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Hi, i'm Calvin and this guide was create to pinpoint the location of titanium bolts around Ratchet & Clank: Size Matters. This guide will help you locate all 20 of the titanium bolts lying around. Get Reading!

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What Are Titanium Bolts?

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Titanium Bolts are the rarest bolts in the whole universe. There are 20 in all to be found, and they are very well hidden. Titanium Bolts are used to unlock skins for Ratchet. You can check how many Titanium Bolts you are missing by going into your ship and looking at each planet.

Although there are 20 Titanium Bolts in the game, only 16 can be spent. The remaining 4 can't be used for anything else.

However, Titanium Bolts aren't required to beat the game.

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Titanium Bolt Locations

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a. Porkitaru = Bolts - 2

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1) After Luna has been kidnapped, go to the point where you have to walk up the wall using gravity boots. You can see a zipline going down to the next area of the game. Look to the left of the zipline and you will see a platform with a titanium bot hanging on it. Either Double Jump + Hover or Long Jump towards it.

2) On the taxi ride through the water, you will make it to a small island with some enemy robots, health and boxes upon it. Jump on the island and follow the coastline around the island to the left house to find the Titanium Bolt.

b. Ryllus = Bolts - 2

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1) At the beginning near your ship, look down the cliff to see a stone platform. Jump down carefully to obtain the Titanium Bolt. Make sure to use First-Person view to be safe (SELECT)

2) After launching yourself through the hole by the last mimic plant on the world (the high one). Turn around and there is your next Titanium Bolt! Quite easy eh?

c. Kolidon = Bolts - 3

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1) At the beginning near your ship, drop down the the right side to a lower level that's covered in dust and rocks. Follow the short path to find a crater with your next Titanium Bolt.

2) Right before walking into the factory, go to it's left side and around some boxes find the Titanium Bolt.

d. Metallis = Bolts - 1

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1) You'll have to get the Polarizer for this one, win it on Omega. Behind your ship, you'll find a door/hatch. Fire-up your polarizer and shoot at it to make

it open. Go through and dodge all the traps and enemies and use your hypershot to make it on a platform with loads of crates with the Titanium Bolt in the middle

e. Dreamland = Bolts - 3

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1) Get to the part of the level where your on a giant hat will three parasols. Jump upon the first parasol and quickly turn around and aim your hookshot up to see the green hook-shot thing. Quickly shoot your hookshot to reach the top of the hat to collect your newest Titanium Bolt or else the parasol will eventually fall leading you to your death.

2) Go through the level until you make it up to the first breakable mirror in the building, don't go inside but instead go to it's left side. Jump over the plant/tree to aquire your next Titanium Bolt.

3) Make it up to the part with the first black portal near the Gadgetron Vendor, look to the left of the Portal to see the Titanium Bolt off in the distance. Whip out your Lacerators and fire at the faraway bolt. You will be transported to a floating box-filled place. Navigate your way on the boxes making sure your not blown up or fall off. Get to the Titanium Bolt at the end and go through the portal. This can only be repeated once each run-through of Dreamland so make sure you dont miss the opportunity!

f. Medical Outpost Omega = Bolts - 1

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1) Right after the Countdown Timer has initialed, get to the wall jump area and jump to the very top, that is right before your ship, turn around to see it on a ledge.

Alternatively you can find it on Medical Outpost Omega near the bed to return dreamland if you have missed it

g. Challax = Bolts - 3

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1) At the start of the level near your airship, drop down behind it to get to a very low area. Continue following the path around to the Titanium Bolt

2) Once you have entered the Technomite City, get to the room with lots of chairs and a coveyor belt, much like an airport. Sit and wait like everyone else until your luggage arrives, a Titanium Belt.

3) At the point where you have to use the Mimic Plant Bomb to knock down the statue, knock the bomb back into the building wall where it will break down to reveal the Titanium Bolt

h. Dayni Moon = Bolts - 2

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1) Near the beginning of the level, you make it to a barn with some sheep inside. Vapourize then all and bring the two mimic plants to the pits. Make sure the larger one is close to the barn and jump on it to reach a small platform of the barn where is Titanium Bolt lays.

2) After hovering down from the high-rise platform, you reach a tall building. Break the Grind-Lock on the door and bring a bouncy mimic plant inside. Fit it in the soil and jump to the Titanium Bolt.

i. Inside Clank = Bolts - 2

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1) After sliding down the first rail near the start, turn around and you'll see a ladder leading back up from where you came. Around the back of ladder is where the Titanium Bolt.

2) Head into the hallway leading to the first spiral. Turn around and look up. You should see a platform high above where the Titanium Bolt lays. Get to the wall that goes from gray to black (shadow like colour) and wall jump from there until you reach the top and collect the Titanium Bolt.

j. Quodrona = Bolts - 1

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1) Make it to the part of the level where the Ratchet clones come out of the boxes. The Titanium Bolt lies on the top of the lower-left (south-west) corner of the room.

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Unlockables  
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The Skins in the game determine what Ratchet looks like. There are four unlockable skins in the game and three are unlocked using Titanium Bolts. Be aware that the extra skins do not provide additional armour for Ratchet.

Skins can be accessed by going to the Menu (START) then Special to look at the skins.

Tropical Vacation

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Cost: 4

Ratchet will his swimming trunks, flippers, snorkel and goggles.

Plundering Pirate Captain Skin

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Cost: 6

Ratchet looks much like a traditional pirate with a peg-leg, eye patch and a hat with the jolly roger.

Ratchetzilla Skin

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Cost: 6

Ratchet now wears a green monster suit, much like Godzilla hence the name.

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Map-O-Matic  
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The Map-O-Matic is a handy tool when needed to find those Titanium Bolts, it shows any hidden areas on your map and this usually means Titanium Bolts. You can simply do this by going into the Menu and choosing Map/Mission

The Map-O-Matic is first available on Dayni Moon for 50,000 Bolts through the Vendor.
