[S04] Game Modes

Quick Rally

A randomly generated stage with a random car; no opponents.

Time Trial

A time trial on a selected stage; a ghost car will represent the fastest saved time for that stage.

Single Rally

A rally of one location. The number of stages depends on the stages unlocked. The choices of manufacturer, car, and driver are available.

Championship

Compete for the WRC championship dueling through all 16 locations. Novice and Professional difficulties are available from the start. Completing Professional unlocks Expert; completing Expert unlocks Extreme.
