Here you'll log in to play Digimon Online,you'll have to enter a name and chose a Digimon pack;

Pack A:Powerfulpack Renamon,Agumon and Monmon .

Pack B:Avaragepack;Renamon,Kotemon and Patamon

Pack C:Maniacpack;Guilmon,Kumamon and Patamon

When you're done your character will leave Teddy and Ivy behind.

Here if you talk to the woman that's facing the exit 2 times then she'll give you your Digimon,now Teddy and Ivy will catch up with you and then you go seperate ways.Now exit the Center going South.

As soon as you step out you'll be challenged,don't worry you'll easily win.Now you should head to the Asuka Inn to save (you should also heal)Now head to the store and by some power charges(I recommend you bye some because you'll get attacked on you're way)Well not much more to Asuka city but if you want you could take the latter in the Inn and go to the south door then head to you're left and you'll see some new places but you should only go into the Yellow house and talk to Divermon there to learn about Card Battling.That's about it for Asuka City.

Here you should stick to going east and if you see 2 roads then go south, continue and you'll eventually come across an Inn, rest and save then continue. As you walk you'll see a way that goes North (it leads to Protocol Ruins) ignore it, Digimon are too strong there. Next stop, Wind Prairie.

When you get here, go down the ladder and you will see a Divermon, talk to it to get the red snapper. This is another important item, just go through the bridge and cross to get to Wind Prairie.

If you head east you'll find Veemon wanting to play a game with you and plays hide and seek (just go south and start pressing X on the trees). If you head north you'll find Seiryu City. If you go south you'll find a tamer.

Here, just search around, Airdramon does nothing but sleep, so just go to the tower and talk to the guy that is standing near the door to the over look he tells you the leader is training at Protocol Ruins, now leave and head back to Wind Prairie, I suggest you train there, if the Digimon are too strong, go back

to Wire forest, you might want to level until level 20 to get your ultimate digivolution, which will be very useful because as I had said there are powerful Digimon there. When you are ready, head to West Wire Forest, and from the exit to Divermon's lake, go north to reach Protocol Forest.

Here, fight the Dokugumon until you get a spider web, an item you will need, now go to the right and you will find a maze, I cant tell you how to get through it, but there are 3 types of grass, and you have to walk through all of them, a hint is to go around, it should help, just keep trying and don't start out going up. You will reach the Protocol Ruins.

Take the path to the right, and you will reach Pharaomon, I suggest you do not talk to it as it is a pretty hard battle, and you might not be ready for it, you can go ahead and try, but remember, if you die its game over and you reload one of your save files, just look in the right of pharaomon, you will see a ledge, jump down, and take the secret path to the other side, talk to the leader, he will tell you to battle MasterTyrannomon, so jump down the ledge and head back to Seyriu city, I suggest you save, you should have money for 99 power charges, just get as many as you can(but if you have a level 20 digimon,Ultimate then he'll be a cinch as well as Pharaomon=P) then take the east exit from wind prairie to reach kicking forest, from there, take the top path and keep heading right, go up the ladder and head over to Tyranno Valley.

Just head all the way up and fight MasterTyrannomon(he has a red carpet,pretty fancy =P), he isn't that hard, after you beat him, head back to Seyriu city and go to the tower and battle the Leader for your first badge! Hooray! Now you have

to go to South Sector, so head to Kicking forest.

Take the bottom path going through the little bridge through the water, then go south, then take a left (try to stick to the higher ground on the south) to reach the Station, you will find out you need a Blue card, so head back to Asuka City to talk to Guilmon to get it(since he was made of it,if you picked maniac pack you'll have Guilmon,but he doesn't count =p).

Go to the inn, and had to the 2nd floor and talk to Guilmon, one of his family members has it and he is going to Seiryu city but guilmon doubts he can make it that far. Go to the pub and talk to the lady, she will tell you about Veemon, so head down to Shell beach and talk to the guy, he will make you a fishing rod if you have the bamboo spear, red snapper, and spider web. This item is very important for getting cards. Now go to the forest inn, Guilmon doesn't have it, and talk to the lady there, now go back to Asuka city and talk to the pub lady, now go back to Seiryu city and talk to guilmon by the inn, he will give you a 8blue card, just head to the station, and guess what! The 8blue card is fake! So head back to the forest inn, go to the basement, guilmon is there and will give you the real Blue Card, now go back to Seiryu city. Well this was probably making you mad,but it's over now.

I really recommend you save, then head to the station and you will head to South Sector. Bulbmon is going to attack you, he is very hard, so I suggest you train before fighting him and get your Blast gauge near full. Once you defeat him the gandola will conteneue on it's way,but since Bulbmon Ran away you wont get any Experiance points.

DRI agents are selected people that are located somewhere in the Digimon World, they will ask you for the DDNA of a certain digimon, DDNA is Digital DNA, when you return to them with that digimon's DDNA, they will let you have that certain Digimon as a partner. But to find the DDNA you will have to battle one of that digimon's digivolutions to receive the DDNA, so for Guilmon, you will have to battle WarGrowlmon and win to receive Guilmon's DDNA. The Guilmon you receive can be put into your party at Piximon or the Doctor. The digimon you receive starts at Level 1(that just isn't fair).

Veemon

DRI-Seiryuu City, down the ladder in the back of the city(he'll say that wargrowlmon isn't here yet).

DDNA- Wargrowlmon is found in Ether Jungle in South Sector, go forward and take a right and pass all the vines an you will reach Wargrowlmon(I have not found him but I read this at Gamefaqs and Neoseekers message boards and faqs). (Asuka South).

Requirements-3 badges,1 digimon in your party,below 20-30 could be lower.

Agumon

DRI-DRI Agent Location: Tyranno Valley, South Sector.

DDNA-Metalgreymon is found in Bulk Swamp, South Sector (Asuka South)

Requirements-Level must be between 30-45.

Patamon

DRI-Central Park, Central Sector

DDNA-Magnaangemon is found in South badland, in the West Sector (Asuka West).

Requirements-Level must be between 45-60.

Renamon

DRI-Seiryu city

DDNA-Taomon is in North Badland W (Asuka West)

Requirements-Level 45-60.

Kotemon

DRI-Mobius Desert, by 3 pillars in the bottom part of the desert screen, West Sector.

DDNA- Kyukimon is found at the Suzaku UnderGround Lake, you can reach there by taking the path that Renamon blocks until you beat the Suzaku leader. Use submarimon to get to the UG Lake. (Asuka South).(Asuka South).

REQUIREMENTS-Level 60-90.

Monmon

DRI-Mobius Desert, by the 2 cactuses in the top left, take the lower left 3 times to reach him, West Sector.

DDNA-Armormon is located in Duel Island, go to Divermon's lake and summon Submarimon to reach Duel Island. (Asuka East).

REQUIREMENTS-Level 60-90

Kumamon

DRI-Mobius Desert

DDNA-GrapLeomon is in Ether Jungle (Asuka South).

REQUIREMENTS-Level 60-90
