3.1 - Morphing Tips
=====

1. Use Yuffie.
Her Conformer + Morph materia, for some reasons, can deal enormous damage even though using the Morph Command.
2. You may also use Vincent.
If you were able to max the damage capacity of his Death Penalty, it will do the same when using the Morph Command.
3. Gelnika's the best place.
Not only that all the monsters here are Morph-able to Sources, it is also a nice good place to level up.
4. Now, here's a materia combo.
