




GETTING STARTED

Congratulations on your choice of "ESPN® Let's Play Soccer by IntelliPlay®!" - Turn on your 3DO Interactive Multiplayer.
- 2. Put the IntelliPlay CD-ROM in the CD-ROM tray with the label side up. When you close the tray, the program will begin playing.
- To exit the title at any time, press the Open/Close button on the Multiplayer and remove the CD-ROM. Or simply turn off your Multiplayer.

The Overlap

CONTROL PAD

It's a good idea to get familiar with the functions of your 3DO control pad. Here's a list of the buttons that control the features of this IntelliPlay title:

Rewind (Left and Right Shift): Moves back to the beginning of the currently playing video.

Directional Pad: Allows you to move up, down, left and right among selections and highlights them as you move. Also lets you toggle between the options on the Options Screen.

Play (A): Plays items you've selected when you're in the program or. . . Toggle (A): Turns options on and off on the Options Screen.

Open (B): Expands the outline for a selected topics list or. . . Close (B): Collapses the outline for a selected topics list.

Menu (C): Returns to the Main Menu screen or. . . Credits (C): Displays a list of credits from the Title Screen.

Play/Pause (►/||): Pauses the currently playing video when pressed once. Continues playing the video when pressed a second time.

TITLE SCREEN

When you start the IntelliPlay program, you'll see a **Title Screen** with two buttons.

- Press the **Menu (A)** button to go to the Main Menu screen and learn more about soccer.
- Press the **Credits (C)** button to view a list of the people who helped to bring you this soccer program.

MAIN MENU

The Main Menu screen appears when you press the A button from the Title Screen. From the Main Menu you can explore the contents of this IntelliPlay title.

To select an item from the Main Menu:

- Use the directional pad to highlight a selection.
- Press the A button to activate your highlighted selection.

From any topics list, you can go back to the Main Menu by pressing the Menu (C) button.

INSTRUCTION

John Harkes and Mia Hamm are your personal coaches throughout "Let's Play Soccer," giving you first-hand knowledge of how to play winning soccer. From the Main Menu, you can choose from three instruction sections — Introductions, Offense, and Defense — each of which has its own topics list.

Exploring a topics list

To explore a topics list for a particular section:

 Select a section from the Main Menu and press A.

Heam Balance

- Scroll through the topics list using the directional pad on your 3D0 control pad.
- 3. Highlight the topic and press

 Play (A). When the item has
 finished playing, the program takes
 you back to the same topics list and
 you're ready to select another item.

If you're playing a video segment and want to go back to the topics list, press the C button.

To collapse the topics list, press the Close (B) button. To expand the list when it has been collapsed, press Open (B) button.

To go back to the Main Menu, press Menu (C).

Autoplay

Autoplay is a special feature that allows you to explore the content without having to select items one at a time. When Autoplay is activated for a group of topics, a graphic appears on your screen between each item telling you that Autoplay has been turned on.

To activate Autoplay:

- I. Select a topics list from the Main Menu and press Play (A).
- 2. From the topics list, highlight the item listed in yellow and press Play (A). The program will play all topics from beginning to end. When all the items have played, you'll return to the topics list.

Remember, if a topic is listed in white, the Autoplay feature is not available. To play a single topic, highlight it and press Play (A).

Point Of Attack

Advance/Rewind

To fast-forward, fast-reverse, or rewind a video segment:

- To fast-forward the video while it's playing, press the right directional arrow (►►I).
- To fast-reverse while the video is playing, press the left directional arrow (| ◄ ◄).
- To rewind to the beginning of a segment, press the Left Shift or Right
 Shift buttons on your 3DO control pad. (See page 2 for a diagram.)

Remember: This information is digitally read and may tend to look a bit jumpy when fast-forwarding and rewinding.

To view a particular video sequence in slow motion:

- Select a topic from any list and press Play (A).
- 2. Press the Play/Pause (►/) button.
- 3. Press the right directional arrow (►►) to "step" through the video frame by frame.
- Press the Play/Pause (►/|) button to continue viewing at normal speed.

OPTIONS

The **Options** feature allows you to customize the look and feel of the program by letting you turn on and off the background music, sound effects, and screen saver.

- Select Options from the Main Menu. Each time you run "Let's Play Soccer," all the options are turned on.
- Using the up and down arrows on the directional pad, position the soccer ball pointer next to the option you wish to customize.

- 3. Turn the selected option on or off by pressing the A button. You can also toggle between the on and off options by using the right and left arrows on your directional pad.
- When you've selected your options settings, press the C button to return to the Main Menu.

Remember: Once you set your options, they remain set that way in the program until you change them or turn off the program.
