


GETTING STARTED



Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual. Make sure the MAIN POWER switch (located on the back of the console) is turned on. Press the RESET button. When the power indicator lights up, press the open button and the disc tray will open. Place the SUPER TRUCKS™ disc on the disc tray with the label side facing up. Press the open button again and the disc tray will close. Attach game controllers and other peripherals, as appropriate. 

Main Menu:

After boot up, you will be brought to the main menu screen. Use the directional buttons to navigate through the menus and press the \otimes button to confirm your selection.



Single Race: Get straight into the thick of the action with a one-off race. Battle against the computer opponents at any unlocked circuit. If you choose to skip qualifying, you star the race from the back of the grid.

Championship: Compete in five championships of ascending difficulty. Trucks and circuits are unlocked by progressing in this game mode.

Arcade: Starting at the back of the grid, the aim is to make each of the 3 checkpoints per lap before the allocated time runs out. Complete the race and finish in the requested position to progress to the next circuit.

Time Trial: You are alone at a track of your choice. Each lap is timed so that fastest laps can be beaten. The number of laps is unlimited.

VS Mode: Race against a friend in this split screen challenge. Ensure that you have two controllers connected before attempting to play a two player game.

Memory Card: Save your current game, or load a previously saved game.

Extras: Access to various other modes and extras in the game

Options: Change game settings and tune up your trucks.

Extras

Survival Mode: You start each race at the back of the pack and then at the end of each lap, the driver in last place is removed from the race. This process continues until only two drivers remain on the track. To progress through to the next circuit, you mush finish the last lap in first place.

Records: If you've saved your game, check out your achievements including fastest lap times from each circuit.

Replay Theater: Play back your saved replays from your memory card.

Trophy Room: If you have saved your progress, you can check out the trophies that you have won through the various game modes.

Playing the Game

After selecting your game mode, it's time to select your team driver. Each team is represented with their own driver and truck. Each truck has their own features and abilities.

Once you select your driver, you need to choose what type of transmission your truck will have. Choose from Automatic or Manual transmissions.

Next, you get to select the handling of your truck.

Race – provides a balanced truck, ideally suited to precision racing.

Drift - dynamic handling set-up which encourages powerslides.

User - uses the settings entered in the truck set-up screen.

In Single Race, Time Trial, VS Mode and Survival mode you get to select which circuit you wish to race on. You can choose up to 15 different circuits that features they own unique racing experience.

Before racing, you get to select how you wish to start off your race by selecting one of the following:

Playing the Game

Practice: You have the opportunity to practice at each track before racing. There are an unlimited number of laps available.

Qualifying: You have five qualifying laps to improve your starting position on the grid. You take control one corner before the start of the first lap. Afterwards the results screen will display the qualifying times and grid positions.

Race: Races have a rolling start with the trucks in 2 by 2 formations in qualifying order. Pole position is on the inside for the first corner. You cannot control your truck until the countdown has taken place and the race starts. The rolling starts mean that the trucks are often bunched up at the first corner, so try to avoid pile-ups!



Around each circuit, several marshalls monitor the behavior of the drivers. Excessive contact or driving off the track may be penalized by the computer slowing you down and taking control of your truck for 10 seconds. This will be displayed by a black flag icon on the bottom left side of the game play screen.



Championships

It is your goal to be the Super Trucks Champion! Five championships of ascending difficulty stand in your way.

If drivers finish a championship on equal points, positions are calculated based on number of wins, then positions. If the drivers still can't be separated, the first win of the series is decisive. Trucks and circuits are unlocked by progressing in this game mode.

Rookie Open



This is the only championship unlocked at the start of the game. Difficulty is geared towards someone playing Super Trucks for the first time. The 4 races across US circuits are short at 3 laps each.

Continental Challenge



Unlocked by a podium finish at the Rookie Open. 6 locations across Europe are host to this championship — each race is 4 laps long.

Super Trucks Championship





Unlocked by a podium finish at the Thunder Cup. The Super Trucks Championship has 10 races and each one is 5 laps in length.
